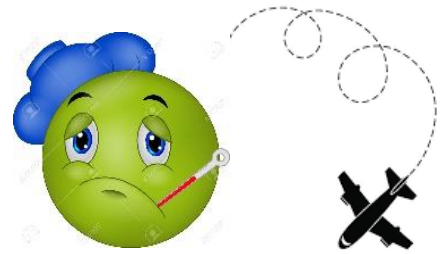


HONORING ALL WHO SERVED

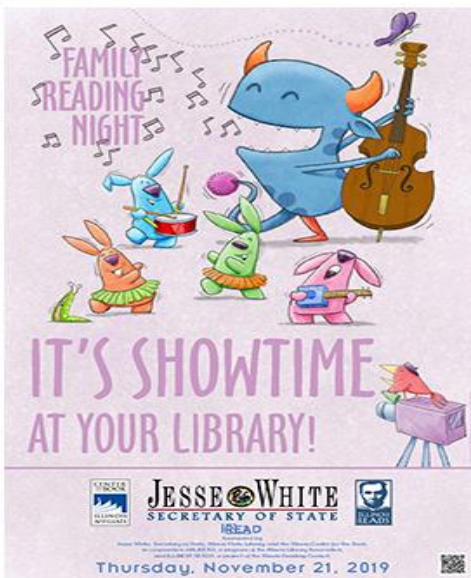

Family Reading Night, sponsored in part by the Illinois State Library, is Thursday, Nov. 21. Students will participate in activities

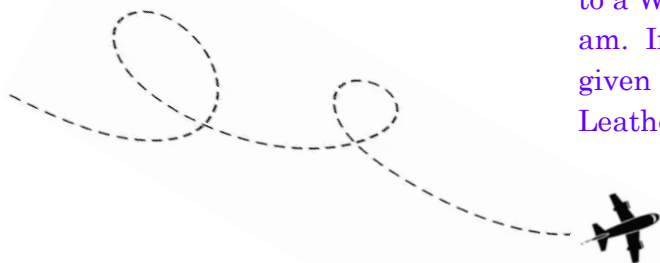
throughout the day to recognize this event. The theme for this year's event is "It's Showtime at Your Library."
