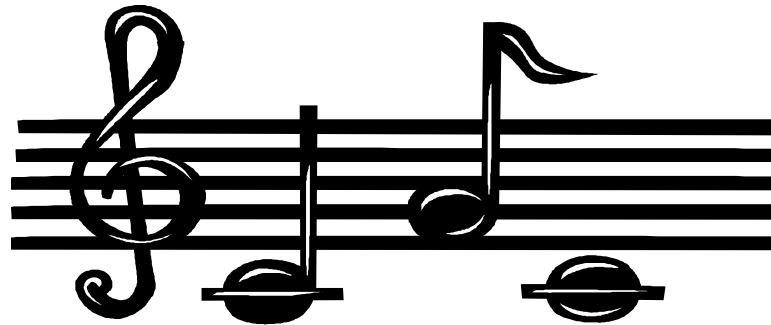


## Junior High Mission Statement:

The mission of Macomb Jr. High School is to provide a challenging educational experience for each student in a safe environment that promotes responsibility, acceptance, and respect.

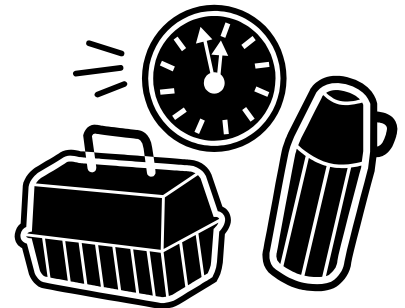

- Padlock- PRACTICE!

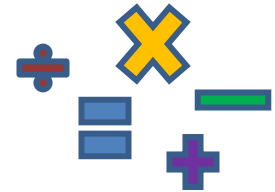
